CONTRACT AGREEMENT FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN – AMERICAN STRUCTUREPOINT

The COUNTY agrees to compensate the Consultant for the performance of the authorized portions of the Work specified in this Agreement. The total maximum prime compensation of all Parts which may be authorized for the subject Agreement is TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000).

AGREEMENT OWNER AND ENGINEER AMERICAN STRUCTUREPOINT ENGINEERING SERVICES COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

Mr. Everson moved, Mr. Lowe seconded, to authorize Commissioner Garrett, to sign on the Commissioners behalf, the engineering contract with American Structurepoint for planning and environmental engineering for the Comprehensive Plan. A. Owner shall pay Engineer for Services a total fee of \$500,000. according to the following fee breakdown:

1. For "Educate (Months 1-6)" Phase, a Lump Sum amount of \$150,000.
2. For "Explore (Months 7-12} Plan Development" Phase, a Lump Sum amount of \$175,000.
3. For "Empower (Months 13-18) Plan Development" Phase, a Lump Sum amount of \$175,000.
4. The portion of the compensation amount billed monthly for Engineer's Services will be based upon Engineer's estimate of the percentage of the total Services actually completed during the billing period.

LPA FEDERAL ODOT-LET PROJECT AGREEMENT

Mr. Lowe moved, Mr. Everson seconded, to authorize Commissioner Garrett, to sign on the Commissioners behalf, the contract with the State of Ohio Department of Transportation. The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth requirements associated with the Federal funds available for the PROJECT and to establish the responsibilities of ODOT and the LPA for administration of the PROJECT – Comprehensive Plan. The total cost for the PROJECT is estimated to be \$200,000.00 as set forth in Attachment 1. ODOT shall provide to the LPA 90 percent of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$200,000.00 in Federal funds. This maximum amount reflects the funding limit for the PROJECT set by the applicable Program Manager and includes the use of 80 percent OVRDC STBG funds and 10 percent Toll Revenue Credits . Unless otherwise provided, funds provided by ODOT shall be applied only to the eligible costs associated with development of the PROJECT.

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE ROSS COUNTY RESIDENTIAL BUILDING DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the citizens of Ross County require the establishment of local enforcement of the building code; and

WHEREAS, The State of Ohio requires the establishment of a building department prior to the exercise of enforcement authority;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF ROSS COUNTY, OHIO,

Section 1: The Ross County Residential Building Department is hereby established.

Section 2: Said department shall have full authority to enforce all laws, statutes and regulations as provided and authorized in the Ohio Revised Code and Ohio Administrative Code pursuant to the Certification approved by the Ohio Board of Building Standards.

Section 3: This resolution is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Ross County and for the further reason that said Code must be enforced and administered according to law and particularly pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code;

Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REQUEST TO THE OHIO BOARD OF BUILDING STANDARDS TO CERTIFY THE COUNTY OF ROSS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE RESIDENTIAL CODE OF OHIO TO EXERCISE ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY AND ACCEPT AND APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, MAKE INSPECTIONS.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY of ROSS, Ohio desires to enforce the Residential Code of Ohio for the purpose of providing uniform standards and requirements for the erection, construction, repair, alteration, and maintenance of buildings specified in section 3781.06 of the Revised Code of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF ROSS Ohio seeks to obtain the authority for enforcement of the provisions of the Residential Code of Ohio through certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards pursuant to Section 3781. 10(E) of the Revised Code to exercise the enforcement authority and accept and approve plans and specifications, and make inspections in accordance with the Residential Code of Ohio;

WHEREAS. the said Board of Building Standards has certified the Ross County Residential Building Department to exercise enforcement authority in accordance with the Residential Code of Ohio, effective 9/23/2024 as set forth in said Board's certification; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in accordance with law to administer and enforce the Residential Code of Ohio within the limits of the COUNTY OF ROSS; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF ROSS, Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring, that;

SECTION I: That Ohio Administrative Code 4101: 8 - Residential Code of Ohio as promulgated by the Ohio Board of Building Standards, shall apply and be enforced within the COUNTY OF ROSS, of Ohio,

SECTION 11: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period permitted by law following promulgated of the Residential Code of Ohio By the Board of Building Standards through the certification process, adoption and effective date of certification issued by the Ohio Board of Building Standards.

SECTION III: The President, Board of Commissioners of the COUNTY OF ROSS is hereby authorized and directed to sign and submit an application to the Ohio Board of Building Standards requesting said Board to certify the COUNTY of ROSS for enforcement of the Residential Code of Ohio.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that said Code must be enforced and administered according to law and particularly pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 3 781 of the Revised Code of Ohio;

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and effective date of certification issued by the Ohio Board of Building Standards.

OHIO FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION COMMISSION GRANT VA MEMORIAL STADIUM TURF REPLACEMENT

Mr. Lowe moved, Mr. Everson seconded, the Ross County Board of Commissioners will supplement the OFCC grant of \$500,000.00 for the replacement of turf at the VA Memorial Stadium, in the amount of \$100,000.00.


